Public Notice 22 /2010

Subject: - Implementation of Indian Customs EDI System 1.5 (ICES 1.5) at Air Cargo Export, New Custom House, New Delhi, under CBEC's IT Consolidation Project regarding.

Attention of the Exporters, Importers, CHAs, Trade Partners and all other agencies concerned is invited to Public Notice No. 21/2010 dt. 19.11.10 regarding migration to Indian Customs EDI System 1.5 (ICES 1.5) at Air Cargo Export, New Custom House, New Delhi, under CBEC's IT Consolidation Project regarding.

2. In reference to paragraph 10 of the said public notice, the exact schedule of migration activities shall be as follows:

(a) Migration activities shall start on 26.11.2010. Consequently all Customs operations on the existing Air Cargo Delhi server (Exports) would cease with effect from 14.00 hrs on 26.11.2010 till the date of launch of application from Data Centre and all work would be handled manually.

(b) Schedule

29.11.2010	ICES 1.5 Goes live.	Subject to successful migration of data.

- a) Punjab National Bank is advised that Desk Manager handling challans should ensure that the challans accepted on 26.11.2010 by the cash officer are either accepted or rejected. There should not be any document pending in the Cash Managers queue at end of day on 26.11.2010 since data from this queue will not be migrated as part of the migration of ICES operations data centre.
- b) The Custodian should note that all IGMs / EGMs details which have been filed through Service Centre should be submitted in the system before 14.00 Hrs on 26.11.2010 failing which these details will have to be re-entered after migration to data centre.
- c) For Service Centre operation it may be noted that all documents entered in the Service Centre and pending for submission must be submitted prior to 18.00 Hrs on 25.11.2010 failing which these would have to be re-entered after migration of ICES operation to Data Centre. For instance, if for a Bill of Entry/ Shipping Bill, a job has been entered and not submitted prior to 18.00 Hrs. on 25.11.2010, it would have to be re-entered after migration of operation to Data Centre.
4. During the period of manual activity, Customs will accept the documents only if prescribed fees have been paid in advance to CMC. Once the System is up, CMC is responsible for entering the data in the new System. The fee payment challan must be attached with all manual documents.
4. Regarding help desk, it is added that Users requiring any clarifications regarding the new application may also interact with the Helpdesk managed by M/s TCS on Toll Free No. 1800-266-2232.
5. Difficulties, if any, faced by the trade may be brought to the notice of the Systems Manager, Air Cargo (Exports), New Custom House, New Delhi.
